On July 31, 2023, Governor Whitmer signed the state budget for the fiscal year starting October 1, 2023 (FY 24). The MDHHS budget for FY 24 includes funding for a \$0.85 per hour wage increase for direct care workers who have been eligible for the \$2.35 per hour wage increase.

Let's make sure we're taking time to enjoy the Michigan summer with our consumers and thanks for all you do to make ALS-LM an amazing place to work and for our consumers to live.

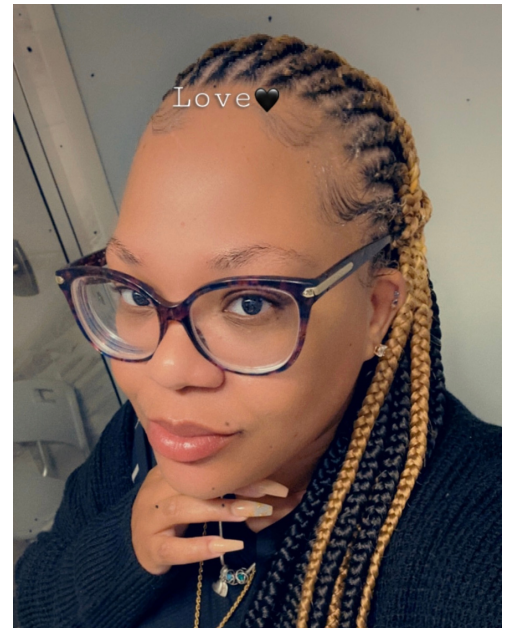


Regional Director Recognition

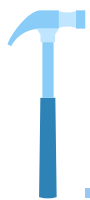

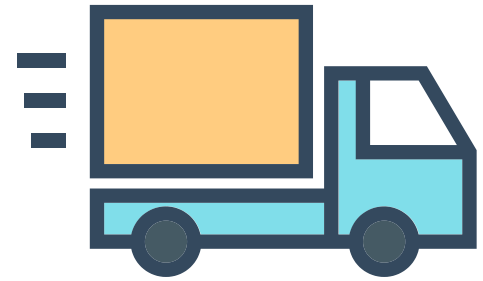
